
Daley Teacher Acknowledged For Instruction

Dr. M. Vali Siadat, a mathematics professor at Daley College, 7500 S. Pulaski Road, received the 2002 Distinguished Teaching Award of the Mathematical Association of America for the Illinois section.

The award is the high-

est form of state recognition a college teacher can receive.

Siadat has taught various math courses at Daley since 1982. He is also the Math Department's chairman.

In 1999, he was nationally recognized for co-developing the Keystone Method of Teaching Mathematics, a form of adaptive teaching that has improved student test scores, with UIC professor Yoram Sagher.
